Vehicle Speed Limit Lowered to 30 km/h on Residential Roads

Starting in September, the legal speed limit for vehicles on residential roads will be reduced from 60 km/h to 30 km/h. Residential roads are narrow streets without center lines or medians, commonly used in daily life.

The Healing Forest: "A Fairy Tale Forest Lit by Lanterns" (Kobe Nunobiki Herb Gardens)

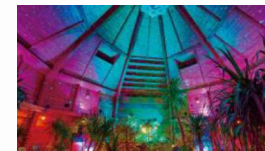
During this event, the music hall has been transformed into a fantasy world of darkness, illuminated lanterns, soothing sounds, fragrances, and plants.
